


Fremont Police Week In Review

Auto Burglary

On 3/14 between 7:25 p.m. and 8:03 p.m. approximately six auto burglaries occurred in the parking lot near Toro Sushi, 43785 Boscell Rd. Suspect(s) shattered vehicle windows and removed items. #220314034, #220314035, #220314036, #220314037, #220314038, & #220314039.

Auto Theft

On 3/11 at approximately 11:20 p.m. officers located a stolen vehicle driving into the Glenmoor Green Apartment Complex, 38822 Farwell Dr. Officers conducted a vehicle stop and detained both occupants who were also in possession of controlled substances. Brandishing

A female suspect standing near the intersection began swinging a butcher knife and threatening to kill two victims who were stopped at the light in their vehicle. Commercial Burglary

On 3/08 at approximately 2:46 a.m. a commercial burglary occurred at La Petit Ma Belle Salon, 43625 Mission Blvd. A witness observed two suspects break a window to the business and make entry. The suspects took money from the register and left on foot prior to police arrival. #220308002

Residential Burglary

On 3/12 between 8:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. a residential burglary attempt occurred in the area of Grover Rd. Suspect(s) entered the victim's backyard and attempted to pry open two doors to gain access to the residence. No entry was made and no loss reported. #220313014

On 3/11 at approximately 1:31 a.m. a catalytic converter theft occurred in the area of Almond Ave. A witness called police after hearing a "metal cutting" sound outside. The witness saw two suspects leaving the scene in a vehicle. Officers arrived on scene and located a vehicle with the catalytic converter removed. #220311001
