

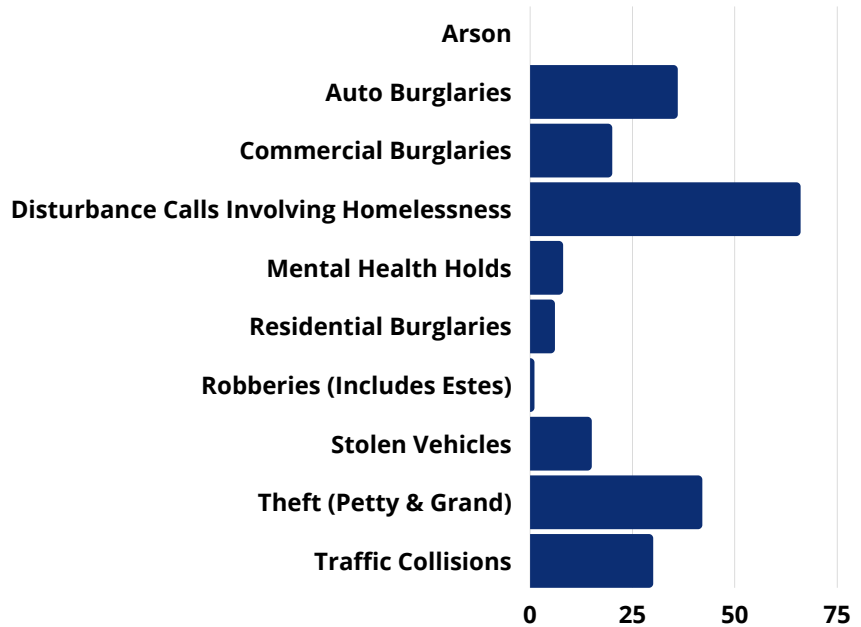


Fremont Police Week In Review

Assault

On 3/12 at approximately 2:32 a.m. an assault with a deadly weapon occurred in the area of Bianca Dr. Victim heard a sawing noise outside and saw two suspects attempting to steal his catalytic converter. Victim confronted the suspects who then made a comment about having a gun. As the victim retreated towards his residence, he heard a single gunshot. A shell casing was located at the scene and the suspects fled in a vehicle. The Gun Violence Task Force is following up. #220321006

Auto Burglary

On 3/17 between 8:36 a.m. and 9:05 a.m. approximately three auto burglaries occurred in the parking lot near Starbucks, 5034 Mowry Ave. Suspect(s) shattered vehicle windows and removed items. #220317010, #220317011, & #220317015.

Auto Theft

On 3/15 at approximately 4:46 a.m. a traffic hazard was reported in the area of Grimmer Blvd and Irvington Ave. A vehicle, equipped with stolen license plates, was stopped in a traffic lane and the driver appeared to be asleep. Officers conducted a felony vehicle stop and detained the driver who was found to be on parole. A search of the suspect/vehicle yielded burglary tools and a controlled substance. Matthew Quiles (33) out of Fremont was arrested. #220312001

Brandishing

On 3/15 a brandishing weapon incident occurred in the 38000 block of Cherry Ln. A male suspect, who had previously threatened staff, was following the victim around the complex with a knife. The suspect retreated to his residence prior to police arrival. A surround and call out was initiated and the suspect was detained. The case was sent to the DA for charging. #220315024

Commercial Burglary

On 3/21 at approximately 12:13 a.m. officers responded to a report of an in-progress commercial burglary at 43353 Mission Blvd #B. Suspect was seen on video surveillance entering the business. Officers arrived on scene and located the suspect walking away from the business. Justin Carruth (38) homeless out of Fremont was arrested. #220321002

Residential Burglary

On 3/15 at approximately 9:35 p.m. a residential burglary occurred on Delaware Dr. Victims arrived home and saw two suspects exiting their backyard. The suspects proceeded to flee on foot and get into a nearby vehicle. It was discovered the residence had been ransacked and several items were missing. #220315046

Between 3/18 and 3/19 a residential burglary occurred on Terra Cotta Cir. Suspect(s) pried open a rear sliding door and ransacked the interior. # 220319011

Theft

Between 3/18 and 3/19 a grand theft of a catalytic converter occurred on Guardino Dr. Suspect(s) removed the catalytic converter from an Acura MDX. The victim located a flashlight underneath their vehicle believed to be left behind by the suspect(s). #220320420
