Assault with a Deadly Weapon

Burglary Tools

On 4/01 at approximately 9:58 p.m. officers responded to a report of a catalytic converter theft that just occurred in the area of Espada Ct. Officers quickly located a vehicle in the area matching the suspect vehicle and detained two males occupants. Burglary tools typically used in catalytic converter thefts could be clearly seen inside the vehicle. One of the suspects was on searchable probation and had a history of catalytic converter theft. Robbery
