


Fremont Police Week In Review

Assault with a Deadly Weapon

On 4/14 at approximately 7:52 p.m. officers responded to an assault with a deadly weapon in the 41000 block of Albrae St. A female victim reported she had been stabbed inside her motorhome. The victim suffered a non-life threatening injury but was unable to provide any investigative leads. #220414033

Brandishing Weapon

On 4/15 at approximately 10:07 p.m. a brandishing weapon incident occurred at The Huddle Bar, 5152 Mowry Ave. It was reported that a heavily intoxicated male suspect had brandished a knife and that several bar patrons had the suspect restrained and had taken the knife from him. Officers arrived and detained the suspect. Thomas Kimmich (54) out of San lose was arrested. #220415026

Commercial Burglary

On 4/16 at approximately 12:25 a.m. a commercial burglary occurred at Windsor County Drive Care Facility, 2500 Country Dr. A male suspect began pounding on the locked entry door. The suspect then threw a boulder at the glass causing it to shatter and made entry. Officers arrived and detained the suspect.
