


Fremont Police Week In Review

Arson

On 4/29 at approximately 2:31 a.m. an arson occurred in the area of Raindeer Ct. A witness reported seeing a unknown male suspect throw something at a neighbor's front door and the door immediately catch fire. The suspect then promptly fled the scene on foot. #220429002

Auto Burglary

On 4/26 between 6:15 p.m. and 7:15 p.m., three auto burglaries occurred at Spin A Yarn Steakhouse, 45915 Warm Springs Blvd. Suspect(s) shattered vehicle windows and removed personal belongings. #220426051, #220426053, & 220426055

Auto Theft

On 4/26 at approximately 4:02 p.m. detectives recognized a stolen vehicle in the parking lot near Tango Sushi, 4193 Cushing Pkwy. Upon seeing officers, the suspect immediately attempted to flee on foot but was quickly apprehended. Luis Hernandez (25) out of Hayward was arrested. #220426041

Commercial Burglary

On 5/01 at approximately 12:41 a.m. a commercial burglary occurred at 44053 Fremont Blvd. Officers were dispatched to an alarm call at the business. A bicycle was located outside of the business and upon entry into the building, officers located a male suspect. The suspect was in possession of a controlled substance, key rings, and petty cash. Juan Aguilar (49) homeless out of Fremont was arrested. #220501003

Between 4/30 and 5/01 a commercial burglary occurred at The UPS Store, 4700 Warm Springs Blvd. Suspect(s) shattered a glass window to gain entry and took several packages and stamps. #220501010

Residential Burglary

On 4/30 at approximately 5:00 a.m. a burglary of a garage occurred on Xanadu Tr. Suspect(s) accessed a garage door opener from victim's vehicle that was parked outside of the residence. Suspect(s) then used the opener to get inside the victim's garage and steal a separate vehicle, along with the victim's credit cards. The cards were then used at various locations in Fremont. #220430014

Robbery

On 4/27 at approximately 10:00 a.m. a robbery occurred outside of HSBC Bank, 39410 Fremont Bank. Victim was attempting to use the ATM when a male suspect began harassing him. Victim proceeded to walk away and the suspect followed him, assaulted him, and took his wallet. The victim confronted the suspect and kept him on scene until officers arrived. Charles Sona (50) homeless out of Fremont was arrested. #220427014

Shooting into an Inhabited Dwelling

On 4/30 at approximately 11:00 p.m. a possible shooting into an inhabited dwelling occurred in the area of Mohawk River St. Victim heard what sounded like approximately 5-6 gunshots. The next day, victim discovered what appeared to be a bullet hole in a neighbor's vehicle. No casing were located at the scene. #220501014
