

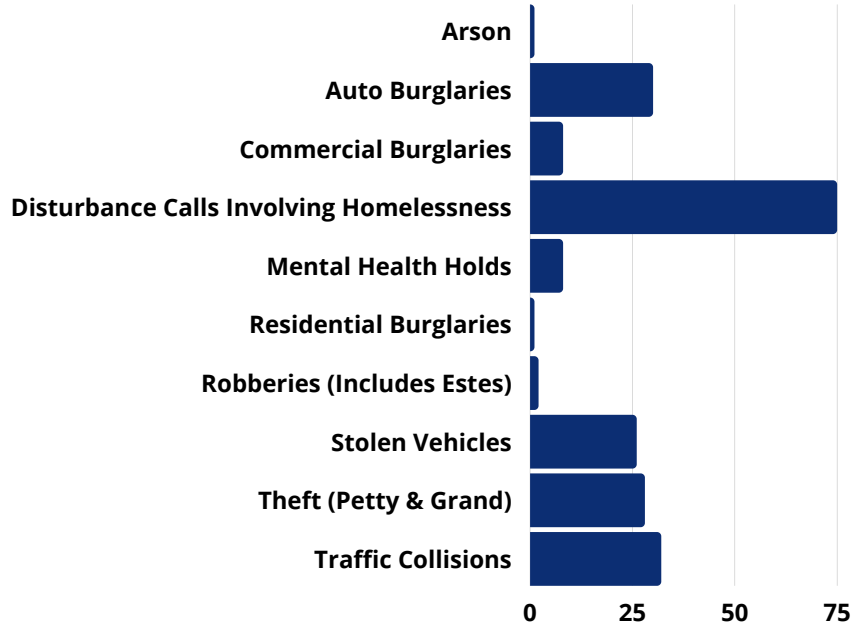


Fremont Police Week In Review

Auto Burglary

On 6/15 in the early morning hours, approximately twelve auto burglaries occurred in the area of Corrigna Dr, Tan Bark Dr and Commerce Dr. Suspect(s) shattered several vehicle windows in search of valuables. #220615007, #220615008, #220615009, #220615010, #220615011, #220615014, ##220615015, #220615016, #220615018, #220615019, #220615021, & #220615023.

Auto Theft

On 6/15 at approximately 10:18 p.m. officers located a stolen vehicle at the ARCO, 5012 Stevenson Blvd. Officers contacted the driver of the vehicle and detained him without incident. A second suspect was located inside of a clothing donation bin that was adjacent to the stolen vehicle. Indecent Exposure

Robbery

The male suspect then threw a bottle of hand sanitizer at the victim and left the store without paying for an item. Officers responded and located the suspect. Theft

On 6/14 at approximately 8:37 p.m. officers were dispatched to a "grab and run" theft that just occurred at Costco, 43621 Pacific Commons Blvd. Officers quickly located the suspect vehicle in the area and conducted a vehicle stop. The loss from Costco was recovered and two male suspects were detained. Kevin Herman (32) and Peter Tata (38) both out of Fremont were arrested. #220614031
