


Fremont Police Week In Review

June 21, 2022 - June 27, 2022



Arson

On 6/25, officers responded to a report of an individual lighting a dumpster on fire near Grimmer and Irvington. Officers located the suspect, who was positively identified by a witness. One adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested. #220625006

Commercial Burglary

On 6/26, officers responded to a verified alarm call where security watching live video reported seeing two suspects inside the building stealing copper wire. Based on the description provided, these were similar suspects from the two prior commercial burglaries. Officers arrived, set up containment, contacted and arrested one suspect who was seen fleeing out the back of the business. Officers located another suspect a few blocks away, who admitted to being inside the building earlier. Two adult suspects out of San Jose were arrested for commercial burglary, possession of drugs, and stolen credit cards. #220626020

Domestic Violence

On 6/21, officers were dispatched to the Sundale North Apartments for a report of domestic violence and learned that two adults in a dating relationship got into a physical altercation after an argument. Based on visible injuries and statements, one individual was determined to be the dominant aggressor. One adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested. #220621037

Evading Police

On 6/24, a vehicle that evaded a pursuit conducted by Oakland Police, Almeda County Sherriff's Office, and the California Highway Patrol was spotted by a Fremont Police officer at Alvarado Blvd and Lowry Road. The officer initiated a pursuit and successfully performed a Pursuit Intervention Technique (PIT) maneuver to stop the vehicle. The driver, a juvenile, was taken into custody and a replica firearm was located inside the vehicle. Oakland Police responded and took custody of the juvenile suspect. #220624024

Robbery (Estes)

On 6/22, officers were dispatched to a robbery which occurred at the CVS on Driscoll. A suspect stole some soap and an electric razor, and hit several store employees when confronted by them. The suspect fled on a bicycle when officers were en-route. Officers located the suspect in the Five Corners area. One adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested. #220622030

Robbery and Assault with a Deadly Weapon

on 6/27, officers were dispatched to Marshalls at the Fremont Hub for a report of a suspect inside the store chasing people with a machete. The reporting party indicated the suspect used force to steal merchandise from the store earlier in the evening. Prior to officers arriving, the suspect left on foot. Officers located the suspect near Fremont and Beacon and the suspect surrendered without incident. The weapon was located and was determined to be a hatchet. The suspect out of Fremont was found to have an outstanding no-bail felony warrant for violating his parole for robbery. #220627035

Vehicle Pursuit

on 6/26, an officer located a stolen vehicle in the area of N/B 880 and Mowry and recognized the driver who is someone with outstanding warrants. The officer initiated a short vehicle pursuit on N/B 880, which terminated at Alvarado/880 after the vehicle struck the center median and became disabled. The driver and two other subjects fled in multiple directions. A witness reported seeing one of the subjects ran into Lucky's at Charter Square. Based on the possibility of the outstanding subjects being armed, Lucky's was immediately evacuated. Officers located one suspect inside the store and he was positively identified by the witness as fleeing from the suspect vehicle. A citizen from a nearby residence later reported seeing another suspect getting into an Uber. A perimeter was set up with drone and K-9 deployment. Units from Union City, California Highway Patrol, and San Jose Police Air Unit assisted with the search. Inside the vehicle, officers located an assault rifle, loaded AR15 magazine, an extended Glock magazine, and one of the suspect's driver license. One adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested. #220626027
