


# Fremont Police Week In Review

June 28, 2022 - July 4, 2022



#### Alert for Carjacked Vehicle

On 6/28, officers responded to an Automatic License Plate Reader (ALPR) Alert around Ardenwood Blvd and Highway 84 of a vehicle that was carjacked out of Oakland. The suspect in the carjacking had forcefully took the vehicle from the victim. Community Cameras showed the vehicle turned into a nearby gas station. Officers arrived just as the driver of the vehicle boarded to drive off. One adult suspect out of Oakland was arrested for driving the carjacked vehicle and for an outstanding felony warrant. #220628021

#### **Battery/Threat of Violent Crime**

On 7/1, officers were dispatched to a report of a fight at Irvington Park. Officers located the victim and obtained the descriptions of two suspects. One of the suspects was also supposedly armed with a firearm. Additional officers arrived and located the suspects nearby in a vehicle. In the end no firearm was located. Two adult suspects out of Fremont were arrested. #220701002

#### Brandishing a Weapon/Threat of Violent Crime

On 7/3, officers responded to a report of a shooting at a motel on Mission Blvd. According to the report, a fist fight between two co-workers occurred and one of the co-workers (suspect) brandished a gun and threatened to hurt the other. The suspect then fired the gun into the air. Upon officers' arrival, the suspect fled over a fence into a greenbelt area. A perimeter was established, and commands were given for the suspect to surrender. Ultimately the suspect disarmed, climbed back over the fence, and surrendered to officers. The suspect had a loaded hand gun magazine and an unspent round. An additional unloaded firearm was located in the area where the suspect was hiding. One adult suspect was arrested. #220703001

#### Family Disturbance/Assault with a deadly weapon

On 7/2, officers responded to a family disturbance where a suspect assaulted a family member with a metal object, resulting in a laceration to the victim's leg. The suspect then threw a heavy glass vase at victim, but the vase did not hit the victim. Upon officers' arrival, the suspect was found to have concealed weapons on the body. One adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested. #220702009

#### **Felony Vandalism**

On 6/28, officers responded to the area of Dusterberry way for a suspect who was swinging a pole at passing motorists. As officers approached he began throwing rocks at passing cars. The pole used for swinging was a city-owned sign that the suspect pulled out of the ground. One adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested. #220828012

#### **Residential Burglary/Mental Health Hold**

On 7/1, FPD Dispatch received a 911 call about a possible residential burglary in progress on Lincoln St. The victims awoke to a suspect in their residence. They also advised that they possibly knew the suspect. As officers were checking the area, the suspect called 911 and was making threats of danger to the self. Officers located the suspect at the suspect's residence and determined the suspect met the criteria for a 5150 Mental Health Hold. One adult suspect out of Fremont was placed on a 5150 Mental Health Hold. #220701009, #220701010

#### **Outside Assist/Pursuit**

On 7/3, Newark PD called to advise they were in a pursuit of a suspect and the pursuit was possibly headed towards Fremont. Fremont Police officers intercepted the suspect vehicle as it entered the City and took over the pursuit. A short pursuit ensued, and the suspect fled from the vehicle on foot. The suspect was apprehended a short distance away by a Fremont Police K-9. Newark PD responded to the scene and took custody of the suspect. #220703031

#### Vehicle Theft

On 6/29, FPD Dispatch received a 911 call from a security monitoring company that was watching two suspects steal a vehicle from a car sales lot on Brandin Ct. Officers immediately responded and located one of the involved stolen vehicles leaving the scene. One adult suspect out of San Ramon was arrested. #220629002
