


Fremont Police Week In Review

Assault with a Deadly Weapon

On 7/13, officers responded to a residence on Old Canyon Rd to investigate a report of an assault with a deadly weapon. The investigation revealed that an adult suspect struck a juvenile victim in the head with a fist, which contained a rock. The juvenile victim was able to avoid most of the contact and did not suffer any visible injuries. One adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested. #220713023

On 7/15, officers responded to a report of a suspect hitting someone (victim) with a metal bar near the area of Blacow Rd and Gatewood St. Officers arrived on scene and contacted the suspect. The investigation revealed the victim had approached the suspect and confronted the suspect about physically assaulting the victim's spouse on a previous day. The victim was in the process of calling the police when the suspect removed a metal bar from a shopping cart and struck the victim in the face. The victim and the subject got into a physical altercation until police arrived. One adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested. #220715015

Aggravated Assault

On 7/16, officers responded to a report from a Lyft driver (victim) who was sprayed in the face with pepper spray by a customer (suspect). During pickup, the driver and the customer got into an argument about the number of passengers allowed on the ride. The customer then canceled and ordered a new ride, which was assigned to a different driver. As the victim drove away, the suspect sprayed the victim with pepper spray. Officers was able to identify and locate the suspect in the area. One adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested. #220716016

Auto Burglary

On 7/13, officers responded to an auto manufacturing plant near Warm Springs Blvd for a report of an auto burglary that occurred earlier in the morning. Upon arrival, officers found 14 vehicles in the employee parking lot were burglarized. Battery

On 7/12, officers responded to a loud disturbance and battery between two subjects at a motor home parked near Leslie St. The two subjects were siblings, where one subject (victim) residing in the motor home had a restraining order against the other subject (suspect). The suspect showed up at the motor home and instigated a fight. One adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested. #220712023

Domestic Violence

On 7/18, officers responded to an apartment on Sundale Ave regarding a suspect who had battered a partner and the partner's mother. The suspect fled just prior to police arrival and was not initially located during a search of the area. Within an hour, a neighbor called to report the suspect had returned to the complex and was sneaking around near the parking garage. Officers arrived moments later and located the suspect. One adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested. #220718018

Mental Health Evaluation Hold

On 7/14, officers responded to the area of Blacow Rd for a report of a subject who was placed on a hold the day prior was now home threatening to burn the reporting party alive. Officers formulated a plan to contact the subject in the house via phone. The subject was cooperative and came out to meet officers. One adult subject out of Fremont was subsequently placed on a mental health hold. #220714036

Vandalism

On 7/14, officers responded to a report of vandalism at a bank on Argonaut Way. Bank employees called regarding a suspect who was damaging the ATM. The suspect was also banging on the door and employees feared the door would break. Officers located the suspect upon arrival. One adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested. #220714027
