

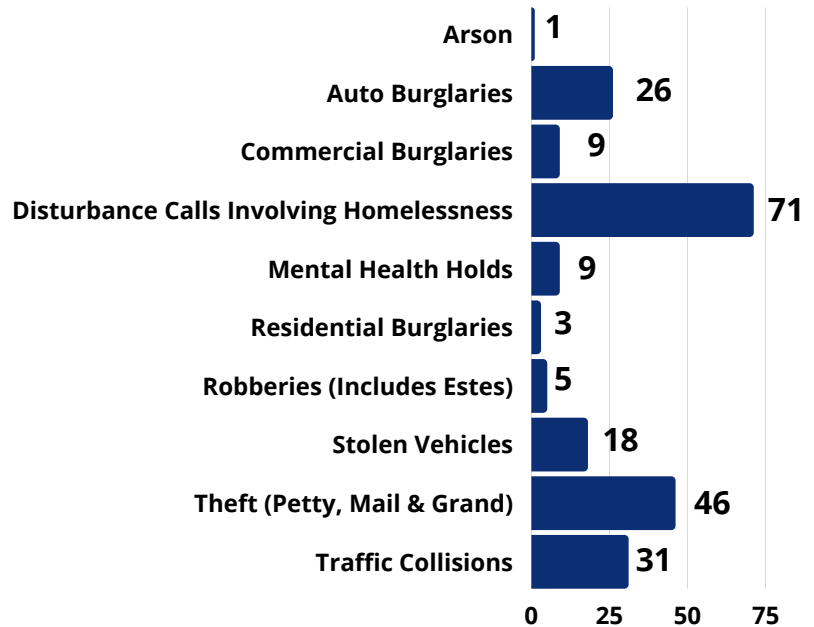


Fremont Police Week In Review

Assault

On 7/27, officers responded to a report of an assault at a grocery store on Fremont Blvd. Two store employees were holding a suspect down. Apparently, the store has previously told the suspect that the suspect is no longer allowed to be in the store. When employees attempted to remove the suspect, the suspect threw a watermelon at them and tried to punch them. One adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested. #220727002

Brandishing a Weapon

On 7/26, officers responded to several reports of a suspect behaving erratically and waving a handgun at patrons at Fremont Hub. Multiple officers arrived and ultimately contacted the suspect on the median at Sundale/Fremont Blvd. The suspect was found to have a BB gun in his possession and was positively identified by a witness. One adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested. #220726024

Domestic Violence/Barricaded Suspect

On 7/26, officers responded to a residence on Kelly St after a suspect feloniously battered his spouse. After evacuating the residence, officers made verbal contact with the suspect at the home, and he promptly barricaded himself in the garage. Several available patrol resources, including multiple K-9s and the Bearcat, responded to assist with a surround and negotiations. After an hour, a Ramey warrant was approved. Officers breached the interior garage door, and the suspect was safely taken into custody. One adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested. #220726026

DUI

On 7/27, a conscientious community member guided officers to an intoxicated motorist who was seen loading children into a vehicle and driving erratically. Officers caught up to the vehicle near Mojave Dr and initiated a stop. The children were not wearing seatbelts but were unharmed. One adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested for DUI and child endangerment. #220727039

On 7/31, officers conducted a vehicle stop in the area of Mission/Warm Springs. The driver was on probation for DUI, had a suspended driver's license from an additional DUI, and was driving under the influence at the time of the vehicle stop. One adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested. #220731003

Stolen Vehicle

On 7/27, officers responded to a stolen vehicle report on Magellan Dr. The victim was asleep in an RV and was awoken by the vehicle alarm of a truck parked across the street. The victim exited the RV, went toward the truck, and confronted a suspect inside the truck, who then pointed a rifle at the victim. A second suspect who was in the driver's seat of a white Cadillac Escalade next to the truck also pointed a rifle at the victim. The victim went back to the RV and called the police. The suspects drove the truck and the white Cadillac Escalade away. This case remains under active investigation. #220729004
