




Fremont Police Week In Review

Commercial Burglary

On 8/13, officers responded to a report of a suspect forcefully entered a photography business in Centerville. The reporting party indicated the suspect was throwing bottles and other items at individuals passing by the area. Officers arrived and one adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested. #220813017

Drunk in Public

On 8/9, officers responded to a report of a suspect causing a disturbance at a grocery store on Paseo Padre Pkwy. Store employees reported the suspect was yelling at customers, grabbed a bottle of vodka, and walked out of the store without paying. The suspect then went to another store nearby and threatened employees there. Officers located the suspect and determined the suspect was heavily intoxicated. One adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested. #220809027

Evading Police

On 8/12, officers responded to an apartment complex on Stevenson Blvd to a report of a suspicious person pushing a motorcycle. Upon officers' arrival, the suspect dropped the motorcycle and fled on foot. Additional officers arrived and coordinated a perimeter with multiple resources, including the drone and the K-9 unit. Officers located the suspect in a nearby area and the suspect surrendered. One adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested. #220812027

Mental Health Hold

On 8/10, officers responded to an assisted living facility on Walnut Ave to a report of a subject entering resident rooms holding a pair of scissors. The subject was unknown to residents and staff at the facility. Officers arrived and located the subject in the rear of the complex. A room-by-room search of the complex was conducted and no residents were harmed. One adult subject out of Hayward was placed on a 5150 mental health hold. #220810036

Resisting Arrest

On 8/14, officers responded to a grocery store on Paseo Padre Pkwy where a suspect was causing a disturbance and was seen to be armed with a handgun in an ankle holster. Upon officers' arrival, the suspect left the grocery store and began walking to nearby businesses. The suspect ignored repeated requests from uniformed officers to stop and told officers he had a gun. Ultimately, the suspect was arrested and was found to have two replica toy firearms in possession. One adult suspect out of Union City was arrested. #220814017

Search Warrant and Arrest

On 8/11, officers served a search warrant at an apartment on Synergy St where occupants of the apartment had complaints of committing package thefts and mail thefts from inside the complex. Officers located two suspects and numerous stolen items at the apartment. Two adult suspects out of San Jose were arrested. #220811015

Theft of Catalytic Converters

On 8/12, officers responded to an auto repair shop on Mowry Ave where the business owner saw a suspect via live surveillance video attempting to steal a catalytic converter. The business owner also reported two catalytic convertor thefts from an earlier day involving a similar suspect seen on surveillance video. Officers immediately arrived at the auto shop and located the suspect. One adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested. #220811003
