


Fremont Police Week In Review

August 16, 2022 - August 22, 2022



Commercial Burglary

On 8/21, a security company called to report a commercial burglary in progress. The security company monitored live surveillance video and saw a suspect breaking into a business on Landing Pkwy and loading a cart with tools and computers. Officers responded immediately and located one suspect, who claimed there were other suspects inside the building. A perimeter was set up, and a search of the exterior and interior of the building failed to locate additional suspects. One adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested. This case remains under investigation. #220821009

Disturbance

On 8/16, officers responded to an auto dealership on Boscell Rd to a report of a suspect causing a disturbance. Store employees reported the suspect was inside the dealership talking nonsense and trying to take vehicle keys. The dealership has had ongoing problems with the suspect causing disturbances and attempting to steal items. One adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested. #220816011

Domestic Violence

On 8/20, officers responded to a report of domestic violence on Adobe Dr. The reporting party was a friend of the victim and stated the victim was just hit by the spouse (suspect) and sustained visible injuries. Officers arrived at the residence and found the victim bleeding with injuries, but the victim denied being hit. Officers interviewed roommates at the house and confirmed a domestic violence incident occurred between the victim and the spouse. One adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested. #220820029

Felony vehicle recovery

On 8/20, officers were alerted to a wanted vehicle via automatic license plate reader (ALPR). The vehicle was wanted from a nearby City for a felony. Officers located the vehicle unoccupied in the Pacific Commons area and towed it. #220820024

On 8/20, officers were alerted to another wanted vehicle via automatic license plate reader (ALPR). Officers located the vehicle exiting a parking lot near Cushing Pkway and Fremont Blvd. One adult suspect out of Newark was arrested, and the vehicle was towed. #220820028

Robbery

On 8/21, officers responded to a robbery at a store on Osgood Rd where a suspect threatened employees with a knife. The suspect attempted to steal a bike but left. Employees stated the suspect was also in the store the previous day and stole a bike. Officers checked the area nearby and located the suspect on the BART platform. An adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested. #220821016

Warrant Arrest

On 8/17, officers responded to a grocery store on Paseo Padre Pkway to a report of a person (suspect) lying in the parking lot. Upon arrival, officers located and contacted the suspect, who was found to have multiple outstanding warrants. One adult suspect out of San Francisco was medically cleared and arrested. #220817003

Warrant Arrest and Vandalism

On 8/21, officers responded to a report of a suspect throwing objects at vehicles as they passed by the area near Mission San Jose High School. Upon arrival, officers discovered three vehicles were vandalized. A search of the area was conducted, and one suspect, who had several outstanding warrants, was positively identified and located. One suspect out of Fremont was arrested. #220821003
