

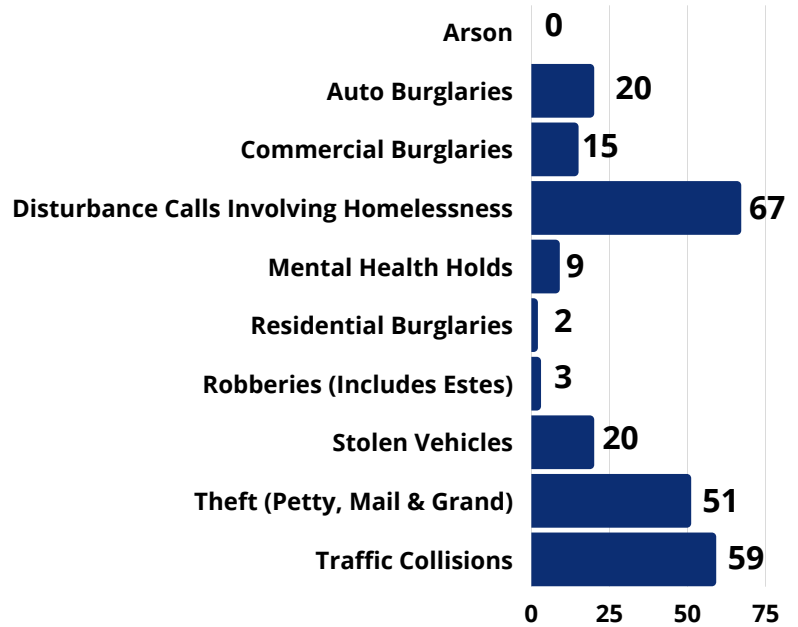


Fremont Police Week In Review

Brandishing a Weapon

On 9/8, officers responded to an apartment complex on Fremont Blvd. The reporting party (victim) called to advise that a subject (suspect) in his apartment complex approached him and began yelling. The suspect then pulled out a knife and threatened the victim. Officers arrived, and one adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested. #220908004

On 9/11, officers responded to the area of the Fremont Main Library regarding a subject (suspect) chasing another subject (victim) with a metal baseball bat. Essentially, two community members got into a verbal altercation with each other. The suspect chased after the victim with the metal bat and threw a watermelon at the victim. One adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested. #220911012

Domestic Violence

On 9/8, officers responded to a disturbance at an apartment complex on Camden St. Officers contacted occupants of the apartment and learned that a domestic battery had occurred. One adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested. #220908002

Occupied Stolen Vehicle Arrest

On 9/12, officers located a stolen vehicle from an automatic license plate reader (ALPR). Officers followed the vehicle, and a traffic stop was initiated at Decoto Rd near Ozark River. The driver yielded without incident. One adult suspect out of Oakland was arrested. #220912010

Robbery

On 9/12, officers responded to an armed robbery at a gas station on Auto Mall Pkwy near Pacific Commons. The victim called to report that four suspects, all armed with handguns, relieved him of his watch. The robbers fled in an SUV just before police arrival. This case remains under investigation. #220912031

Sideshow Activity

On 9/10, approximately 200 subjects involved in a sideshow activity that began in a nearby City made their way to the Ardenwood/HW 84 area. Several reporting parties indicated that one subject was indiscriminately shooting a gun into the air. Officers immediately arrived on scene and provided visual deterrence as the sideshow vehicles began to disperse. The vehicles were funneled toward northbound 880. This case remains under investigation. #220910033

Traffic Collision/DUI

On 9/6, officers responded to a traffic collision near Brophy Dr and Blacow Rd. Involved parties reported minor injuries. The investigation revealed that one of the involved motorists was intoxicated. One adult suspect was medically cleared and arrested for DUI. #220906045
