

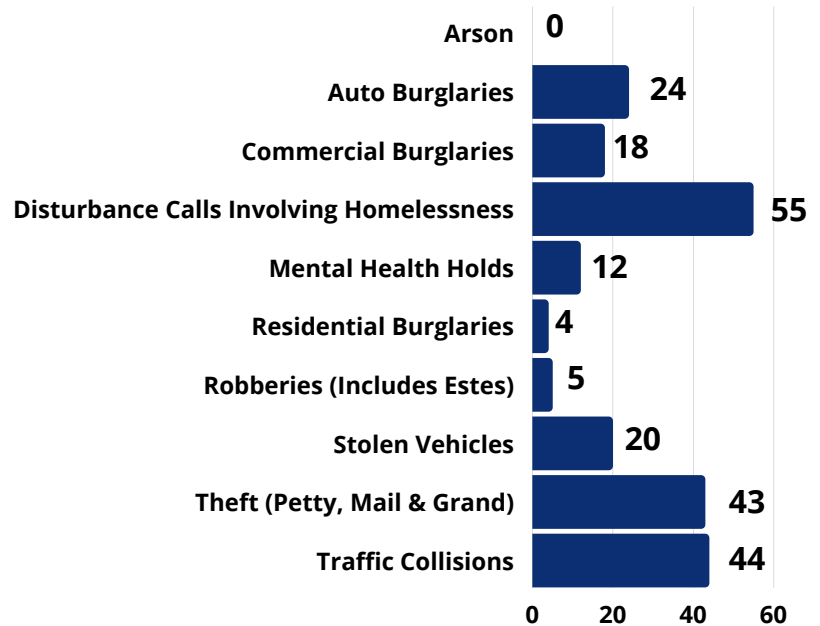


Fremont Police Week In Review

Fremont Police Department has been made aware of several incidents of an unknown subject cutting fiber optic wiring in the Antelope Hills area. Detectives are currently investigating the incidents and will continue to devote resources in an attempt to resolve the criminal activity.

Brandishing a Firearm

On 9/14, officers responded to an incident near Mission and Niles Blvd, where one vehicle was seen brandishing a firearm at another vehicle. Officers responded to the area and located the suspect's vehicle. Officers made an enforcement stop on the vehicle and detained the occupants. Officers found two loaded handguns in the vehicle; both were determined to be ghost guns. Upon further investigation, officers obtained a search warrant for the suspect's residence, where additional firearms were seized. One adult suspect out of Union City was arrested. #220914009

Family Disturbance/Possession of Loaded Firearm

On 9/14, officers responded to a family disturbance on Amberfield Tr. Upon arrival, officers contacted a subject (suspect) who threatened to injure a family member. During the investigation, officers located a loaded firearm reported stolen from another state. One adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested. #220914004

Robbery

On 9/15, officers responded to a robbery at a market on Thornton Ave. Store employees reported a suspect armed with a knife entered the store and stole beer. Officers located the suspect nearby, and the suspect was positively identified through an infield lineup. One adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested. #220915036

Stolen Vehicle Recovery/Theft

On 9/19, officers were alerted to a stolen vehicle that activated the community camera at Fremont Blvd and Sundale Dr. Approximately 20 minutes later, officers located the vehicle on Washington Blvd near a

grocery store. As officers contacted the suspect driver, a simultaneous shoplift occurred inside the grocery store. Officers ultimately arrested the two acquaintances. Two adult suspects out of San Mateo were arrested. #220919041, #220919042

Traffic Collision/DUI

On 9/17, officers responded to a traffic collision on Trinity Way near Bidwell Dr, where a vehicle had struck three other parked vehicles on the street. Officers located the driver (suspect) of the vehicle at the scene. The suspect was intoxicated and was on probation for DUI. One adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested. #220918005

Warrant Arrest

On 9/15, officers were alerted to a stolen vehicle via an automatic license plate reader (ALRP). Officers located the stolen vehicle at a gas station on Auto Mall Pkwy while the occupants (the driver and a passenger) were standing outside the vehicle pumping gas. Officers verified the identity of both subjects and discovered the passenger also had multiple outstanding warrants. One adult suspect out of Fremont and one adult suspect out of Stockton were arrested. #220916003

On 9/17, officers spotted a vehicle with an outstanding warrant for evading a peace officer. Officers located the vehicle unoccupied near Riesling Ct and a witness provided descriptions of the individuals who exited the vehicle. Officers located and arrested a suspect nearby. One adult suspect out of Oakland was arrested. #220917028
