


Fremont Police Week In Review

Ascertain the Problem/False Imprisonment

On 9/27, officers responded to an ascertain the problem call near an apartment complex on Beacon Ave. The reporting party (victim) stated she was walking her dog and was grabbed from behind by a suspect. The suspect restricted the victim's movements, but she scratched the suspect in the face and fled the area. The victim provided a detailed suspect description, and arriving officers were able to locate the suspect nearby. One adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested. #220927055

Battery

On 9/29, officers responded to a battery on Mission Blvd. The victim was walking home when a suspect approached and hugged the victim twice without consent. The victim did not know the suspect before this encounter. The victim managed to get away and provided a description of the suspect to responding officers. Offices located the suspect nearby. One adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested. #220929030

Catalytic Converter Theft/Shooting Investigation

On 10/2, officers responded to Morris Wy for a report of a possible catalytic converter theft involving the suspect aiming a possible firearm and shooting at the witnesses. Officers immediately flooded the area and located the vehicle the suspect was attempting a catalytic converter theft. The vehicle was found to be a stolen vehicle. The suspects fled in another vehicle which was likely an unreported stolen vehicle. Upon reviewing surveillance footage, there appeared to be no shooting, and the suspect threw an item at the reporting party's vehicle. This case remains under investigation. #221002010

Possession of a Firearm/Parole Violation/Probation Search

On 9/27, officers initiated a traffic stop of a vehicle in the area of Paseo Padre Pkwy and Fremont Blvd. Two of the occupants were on parole and/or probation with a search clause and located a large amount of cash inside the vehicle. Officers responded to one of the occupant's residences nearby and seized evidence of fraud, additional cash, a firearm, and other items. One adult suspect out of Fremont and one adult suspect out of Vallejo were arrested. This case remains under investigation. #220927051

On 9/29, officers were conducting a security check at a convenience store on Decoto Rd and noticed a subject acting suspicious inside the store. Officers were able to associate a vehicle with the subject and learned the subject was on probation with a search clause. As the subject exited the store, officers attempted to make contact. The subject resisted and was ultimately detained. Officers located a loaded firearm on the subject. One adult suspect out of Oakland was arrested. #220929038

Robbery

On 10/3, officers responded to a robbery at a parking lot on Osgood Drive. The victim responded to an online ad and was meeting the suspect to buy a cell phone. The suspect got into the victim's vehicle, pulled a knife, and demanded the victim's purse. The victim threw the purse out the window, and the suspect exited the vehicle, picked up the purse, and fled the area in a passenger vehicle. This case remains under investigation. #221003028
