


# Fremont Police Week In Review

November 1, 2022 - November 7, 2022



### **Commercial Burglary**

On 11/4, officers responded to a commercial construction site on Fremont Blvd after security observed, via CCTV, a suspect entering one of the buildings on the property. Upon arrival, officers observed the suspect walking on the second floor of the building. One adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested #221104003

#### **Domestic Violence**

On 11/5, officers responded to an apartment complex on Maple St regarding a male husband (suspect) threatening a female wife (victim) with a knife. The reporting party advised that the suspect was aggressive with the victim because the victim would not buy alcohol. Officers arrived on scene and found that the suspect violated a domestic violence restraining order. One adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested. #221105012

### **Drug Possession**

On 11/4, officers responded to a call of a suspicious vehicle parked in front of a residence on Darwin Dr. The reporting party stated that the vehicle was on, and a subject was passed out in the driver's seat. Upon arrival, officers contacted two subjects and learned they both had outstanding felony warrants and were also in possession of narcotics. Two adult suspects out of Fremont were arrested. #221103013

## **Indecent Exposure**

On 11/2, officers responded to a report of an adult suspect exposing himself while walking around a parking lot on Decoto Rd. The suspect knocked on the victim's car window and then exposed himself. Officers located the suspect, and the victim positively identified him. The suspect had no identification and did not provide his name to the officers. The suspect was arrested and pending identification via fingerprints. #221102025

## **Trespassing**

On 11/7, officers responded to a hotel on Fremont Blvd after employees advised there was a suspect trespassing on the property and gaining access to rooms using a master key. Upon arrival, officers located and arrested an adult suspect. #221108001

### **Other Arrests**

On 11/2, officers made a traffic stop on Osgood Rd and contacted the driver, who was found to have an active warrant. One adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested. #221101035

On 11/2, officers were patrolling in the area of S. Grimmer and Osgood and made a proactive investigative stop on two subjects, both had outstanding felony warrants. Two adult suspects out of Fremont were arrested. #221102011

On 11/3, officers conducted a traffic stop near Baine Ave and Dusterberry way. A warrant check revealed that the driver (suspect) had an outstanding felony warrant for possessing a firearm. One adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested. #221103002

On 11/4, officers responded to a store at the Fremont Hub regarding a suspect creating a disturbance. Officers located the suspect, who was found to have an outstanding misdemeanor warrant. One adult suspect out of Fremont was arrested. #221104016
