

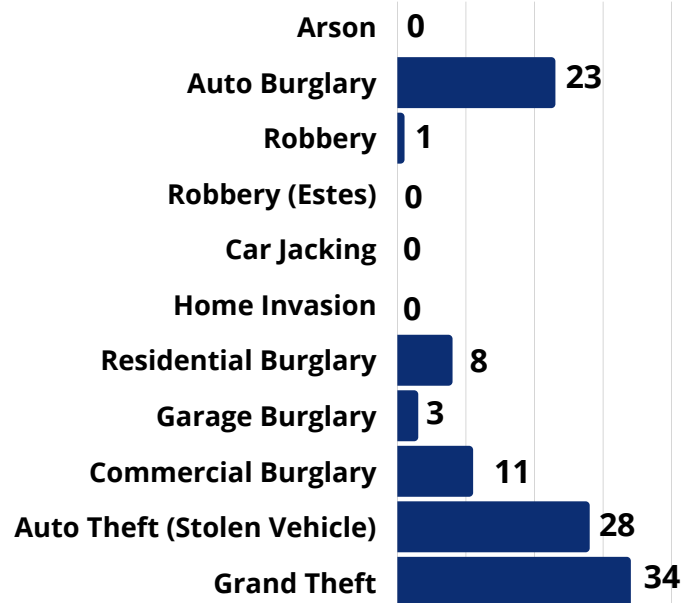


# Fremont Police Week In Review

### Domestic Violence

On 1/11, officers responded to the 5000 block of Shana Street on the report of domestic violence. The victim advised that his girlfriend assaulted him, and he suffered physical injuries. Investigative efforts determined that the girlfriend was responsible for the injuries. The girlfriend, an adult subject out of Fremont, was arrested. #230111014

On 1/12, officers responded to an apartment on Creekside Terrance on the report of domestic violence. A subject grabbed the victim by the throat, and the subject, an adult out of Fremont, was arrested. #230112038

### Evading Police/Major Injury Collision

On 1/17, officers attempted a vehicle stop, and the vehicle evaded at a high rate of speed westbound on Stevenson Blvd near I-880. Officers did not initiate a pursuit. Moments later, the vehicle crashed into a traffic light pole on the northwest side of the Stevenson Blvd and Boyce Rd intersection. Officers arrived on the scene and located the adult driver and an adult passenger trapped inside the vehicle. Other first responders arrived on the scene, and both subjects were transported to trauma centers for their injuries. The District Attorney is reviewing this case for possible charges. #230117004

### Identity Theft

On 1/12, a reporting party (victim) called to advise that her credit cards were stolen as part of an auto burglary that occurred the night before. The victim learned that someone used her credit card at a coffee shop on Civic Center Dr. She contacted the store, and an employee advised that the individual who used the card was still present at the coffee shop. The victim went to the coffee shop and provided Dispatch updated information on the subject who used her credit card. Officers arrived and located the subject in the area. A warrants check revealed the subject to have three no-bail warrants for burglary, possession of a stolen vehicle, and identity theft. The subject, an adult out of Union City, was arrested. #230112017

## Reported Shooting

On 1/16, officers responded to a late reported shooting near Central Ave and Argyle Rd that occurred the night before. The reporting party heard several gunshots in the middle of the night. They reviewed their video surveillance cameras later in the morning and discovered two vehicles were driving by and firing shots into a vacant residence across the street. No other reporting parties or related calls were received at the time of the shooting. This case remains under investigation. #230116008

## Robbery

On 1/15, officers responded to a robbery in a pharmacy at the Fremont Hub. A subject stole several items and brandished a pointed object at an employee. Officers arrived and located the subject walking on Fremont Blvd. A foot pursuit was initiated, and the subject was caught a short distance away. One adult subject out of Fremont was arrested. #230115014

## Trespassing

On 1/12, officers responded to a report of squatters inside a property on the 4000 block of Central Ave. Officers contacted the homeowners to confirm that no one should be at the property. Officers located a subject at the property, who appeared to be under the influence of a controlled substance. A warrants check revealed the subject to have an active misdemeanor warrant. The subject, an adult out of Fremont, was arrested. #230112008
