

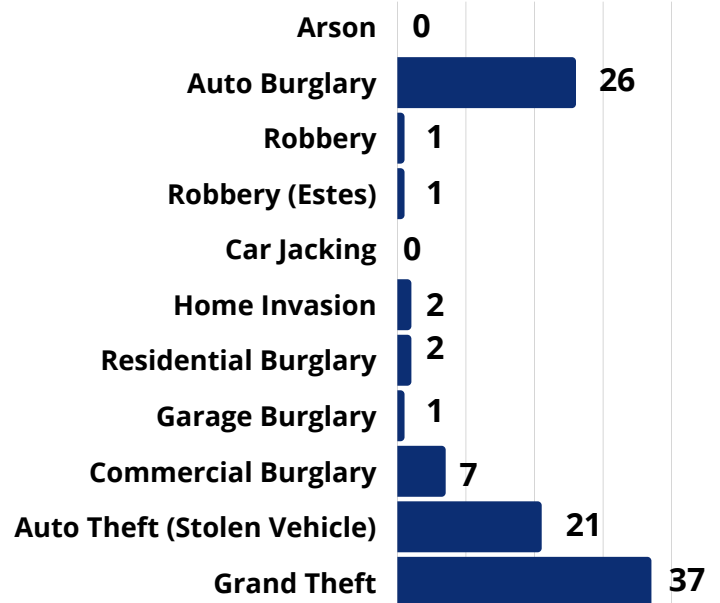


Fremont Police Week In Review

Assist with Pursuit

On 1/17, officers assisted an outside agency with a pursuit where a vehicle entered our city and eventually stopped in the Canyon Heights area. Upon the arrival of FPD units, officers learned that the driver was wanted for carjacking and was possibly armed. Additional FPD units arrived on the scene, and the adult driver was taken into custody. #230118001

Domestic Battery

On 01/23, officers responded to a domestic battery where the reporting party claimed that her spouse battered her. After a thorough investigation, officers determined that both parties battered one another, and both parties were arrested for domestic battery. #230123036

Home Invasion Robbery/Burglary/Abuse

On 1/19, officers responded to a report of an older adult (victim) in an argument with a subject. The reporting party, a neighbor of the victim, learned that a subject had entered the victim's residence, thrown the victim on the ground, and stolen a firearm. Officers arrived and located the adult subject in the area. The subject was positively identified by the victim and arrested. The stolen firearm was recovered near the victim's residence. #230119003

Mental Health Hold

01/21, officers responded to a possible domestic disturbance at an apartment complex on Fremont Blvd. While officers were en route, a male subject (victim) called and advised that he needed help. A female subject immediately called back to cancel the request for help but threatened dispatch and responding officers. Officers arrived and contacted both parties to learn that the female subject was intoxicated and had physically assaulted the victim. Officers detained the female subject; ultimately she was placed on a mental health hold. #230121003

Robbery

On 1/18, officers reported to a report of an injured person walking on Fremont Blvd south of Sundale Blvd. Officers located the individual in the area and found that he had just endured a robbery and suffered a laceration on the arm. The victim was walking home while counting cash in hand. Two subjects approached the victim, demanded the money, and cut the victim with an unknown object. The subjects were last seen fleeing on bicycles southbound on Fremont Blvd. The victim was transported to an area hospital for treatment. This case remains under investigation. #230118009

Possession of a loaded firearm

On 1/21, officers responded to what sounded like an ongoing domestic violence incident in an apartment. Upon arrival, officers heard a verbal argument and contacted an adult subject in the doorway. The subject attempted to flee and was arrested. During the arrest, a loaded pistol with an extended magazine fell out of the subject's waistband. Officers froze the apartment, authored a search warrant, and recovered additional ammunition and a magazine. #230121013

Misc Public Service

On 1/23, officers responded to a possible drug overdose in Tanglewood Park. Officers located the individual and administered two doses of Narcan. The subject was revived, and additional first responders arrived to provide medical treatment. #230123024
