Armed Robbery

On 1/24, officers responded to a report of an armed robbery at a convenience store on Fremont Blvd. An adult subject entered the store and demanded tobacco products and cash. The clerk saw what appeared to be the muzzle of a handgun. The subject was last seen fleeing on foot northbound through the parking lot. This case remains under investigation. #230124046

Assault with a Deadly Weapon

On 1/30, officers responded to an assault at a retail store on Osgood Rd. Two customers got into an argument over a parking space, which escalated to the point where one subject intentionally attempted to drive their vehicle into the other subject. Officers arrived and detained all involved parties, and eventually, an adult subject out of San Jose was arrested. #230130020

Evading Arrest/DUI

On 1/29, officers responded to a manufacturing company on Fremont Blvd to a report of a subject driving under the influence in the company parking lot. At one point, the subject crashed into a parked car in the lot. Officers arrived on the scene and attempted to stop the subject, but the subject fled in his vehicle. No pursuit was initiated in accordance with FPD policy. About three hours later, the subject returned to the company and fled as officers responded. Officers located the subject's vehicle, and an adult subject out of Oakland was arrested. #230129031

Mental Health Evaluation

On 1/24, a reporting party advised that her sister (subject) was driving a car on Mowry Ave and having a mental health crisis. The subject was driving erratically and then stopped in an attempt to pull the reporting party out of the vehicle. The reporting party locked herself in the now parked vehicle, with the subject remaining outside of the vehicle. Officers, including the Mobile Evaluation Team members, arrived, and the subject was eventually transported to the hospital on a mental health hold. #230124030

Threats to Commit Violent Crime

On 1/29, officers responded to multiple reports of a person wielding a machete near Grimmer Blvd and Paseo Padre Pkwy and threatening to harm passing motorists. Officers arrived and located the subject, who was hiding a machete in the bushes. The subject, an adult out of Fremont, was arrested. #230129008

Warrant Service

On 1/27, officers were serving a warrant and located the subject's unoccupied vehicle near Colby St and Gatewood St. With the help of additional surveillance officers; patrol units surrounded the area with the plan to apprehend the subject. The subject exited a nearby residence and entered the vehicle. A short pursuit was initiated, and the subject was taken into custody without incident. #230127024

Grand Theft/Possession of Narcotics for Sale

On 1/26, Officers responded to a report of a catalytic converter theft on Mobile Court. The subject was seen fleeing in a passenger vehicle. Officers located the vehicle and initiated an investigative stop. Two adult subjects were contacted, and both were on searchable probation. A search of the vehicle yielded a large amount of cash, narcotics, a scale, four catalytic converters, and some tools. Both subjects were arrested. #230126005
