Grand Theft

On 2/1, officers responded to an apartment complex on Fremont Blvd for a jewelry swap report. A victim was sitting in the courtyard when two subjects approached her and showed them pieces of fake jewelry. The subjects placed a fake gold necklace over the victim's neck and simultaneously stole the victim's real gold necklace. The subjects fled in a black Jeep Grand Cherokee with no plates. This case remains under investigation. #230201029

Gun Violence Restraining Order

On 1/31, officers initiated an investigation involving numerous complaints of erratic and dangerous behavior by a resident on Hastings St. The subject's behavior had escalated recently, and he began making firearms threats. Officers applied and obtained a Gun Violence Restraining Order (GVRO) for the subject to prevent potential gun violence. A team of officers was assembled to serve the GVRO. The subject was detained without incident, and a search warrant was sought to remove the subject's firearms. Firearms seized from the house included pistols, shotguns, rifles, and an illegal assault weapon. This case remains under investigation. #230131016

Mental Health Evaluation Hold

On 2/2, officers responded to the 41000 block of Osgood Rd to a report of a family member in crisis. The subject ran into traffic, armed with a shovel and other damaging items. Additional units, including members of the UAV (drone) team, arrived but were unable to locate the subject. Shortly later, the reporting party called to advise that the subject may have been seen at the Pacific Commons Shopping Center. Officers responded and safely located the subject, who was transported and placed on a mental health evaluation hold. #230202029

Residential Burglary

On 2/4, officers responded to Capulet Circle to a report of a residential burglary. The reporting party was asleep when he woke to the sounds of an individual rifling through his personal belongings. The subject and the reporting party confronted one another, and a verbal argument ensued. The subject fled, and the victim

was not injured. The point of entry was an unsecured living room window. This case remains under investigation. #230204036

Stolen Vehicle

On 2/6, officers en route observed a suspicious truck near an apartment complex on Fremont Blvd. The truck had two occupants, and the driver tried to walk away from the vehicle as soon as he saw the officers. Officers quickly learned that the vehicle was stolen and detained both the driver and the passenger. The driver was arrested for the stolen truck, and the passenger was arrested for an outstanding misdemeanor warrant. Both adult subjects were out of Fremont. #230206009

Threat to Commit Violent Crime

On 1/31, a manufacturing company contacted dispatch after employees reported seeing an unknown subject driving a white van and threatening to shoot people who walked on Quantum Dr. Officers responded to the area but were unable to locate the van or any victims of a crime. About two hours later, officers responded to a similar call where a reporting party indicated a subject in a white van brandishing a firearm. This incident also occurred near Quantum Dr. A report was taken, but officers could not identify any subject(s) or vehicle at the time. Due to the repeated incidents, officers remained in the area. Shortly after, another victim called 911 reporting a subject in a white van brandished a black rifle and threatened to shoot him. Officers located the subject vehicle on Innovation/Ambition St and conducted a stop. The subject, an adult out of Fremont, was arrested, and a black pellet rifle was seized from the vehicle. #230131026

Welfare Check

On 2/4, officers responded to a welfare check request at a residence on Lake Garrison St. The reporting party is a family member of an older person residing at the residence, and they have not been able to contact the person for a week. Officers entered the residence with the reporting party and found the person deceased. Fire also responded to examine the body. There was no sign of foul play, and the case was a natural death. #P23013918
