

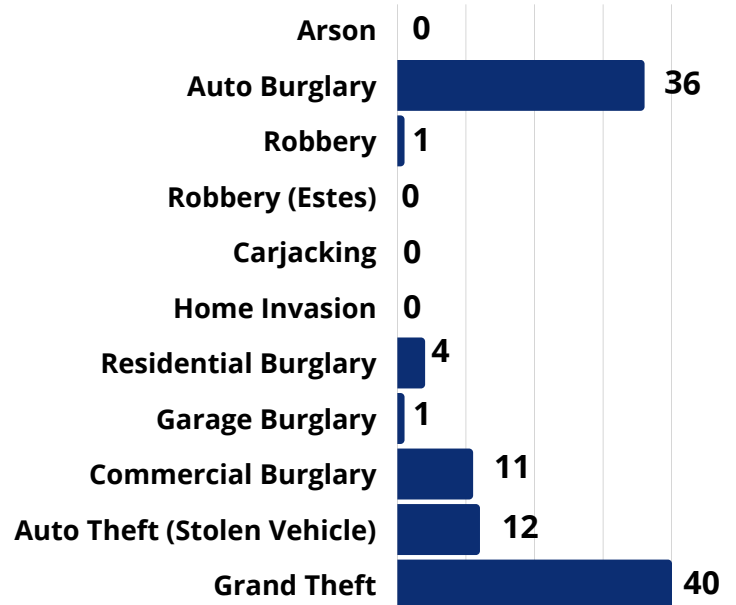


Fremont Police Week In Review

Domestic Battery

On 2/8, officers responded to a domestic battery at an apartment complex on Lexington St. The victim advised that the subject hit her, and she had a restraining order on the subject. The subject was also on probation in a neighboring county for several domestic violence incidents. Officers located the subject at a nearby Bart station platform and arrested him. #230208042

Felony Vandalism

On 02/8, officers investigated a vandalism at an automotive dealership on Fremont Blvd. The reporting party had video surveillance of a subject kicking a vehicle's door, causing damage. Officers detained the subject in the parking lot, and the victim positively identified the subject. The subject, an adult out of Fremont, was arrested. #230208040

Outside Assistance

On 2/8, officers responded to the Alameda Creek Trail for a possible robbery. Officers arrived and located an outside agency on the scene speaking to a female victim and learned that the subject was her boyfriend. While officers determined the crime had occurred outside Fremont's jurisdiction, they remained on the scene while negotiations took place. The subject, an adult out of Fremont, was arrested by the outside agency. #230208018

Possession of Burglary Tools

On 2/7, officers patrolling the Metro Crossing area contacted two subjects and learned that both subjects were on searchable probation. Officers found burglary tools in both subjects' possession. Two adult subjects out of Fremont were arrested. #230207041, #230207044

Possession of Stolen Property

On 2/12, officers responded to a call involving a subject riding a stolen bicycle. The subject was seen riding the bicycle into an apartment complex on Mowry Ave. Officers checked the area and were able to locate the bike. Officers also found a subject in the area that possessed the key to unlock the stolen bike's locking device. The subject, an adult out of Fremont, was arrested. #230212012

Robbery

On 2/11, officers responded to the report of a robbery at an apartment complex on Crawford St. A subject pointed a firearm at the victim as he walked out to his vehicle and demanded property and food. The subject then fled on foot toward Mission Blvd. The victim was not injured. This case remains under investigation. #230211020

Warrant Service

On 2/11, an outside agency advised FPD regarding a wanted subject possibly in the area of Bradley St. Officers responded and located the subject fleeing out the back of a residence. Additional units, including members of the K-9 team and UAV (drone) team, arrived and spotted the subject running back toward the residence. After a search of the residence and surrounding areas, officers located the subject inside the residence. The subject, an adult out of Fremont, surrendered peacefully and was taken into custody. #230211009
