




# Fremont Police Week In Review

### Brandishing a Weapon

On 2/17, officers responded to reports of someone brandishing a firearm in the Warm Springs area near Brown Rd. Multiple callers reported seeing a subject with a rifle pointing it at buildings and trains. As Officers began to flood the area, employees of a nearby business reported a man with a rifle and pistol inside their business. The subject pointed the pistol at employees. As this occurred, officers arrived, and the subject emerged, holding a firearm in the air. One adult out of Hayward was safely taken into custody and arrested. #230217006

### Homicide

On 2/16, a homicide occurred near Stevenson Blvd and Paseo Padre Pkwy. One suspect was identified and arrested on the same day, and charges have been filed with the Alameda District Attorney's Office. ### Mental Health Evaluation

On 2/20, officers responded to the residence on the 4000 block of Phebe Ave. Family members were awakened by the smell of smoke and discovered that their family member had set a fire in the laundry room. Fremont Fire also arrived on the scene. All occupants safely evacuated the home, and first responders quickly extinguished the fire. Ultimately, an adult subject out of Fremont was placed on a mental health evaluation hold. #230220001

### Petty Theft

On 2/14, officers responded to a residence on Driscoll Rd to the report of a subject in the backyard of the reporting party. The reporting party recognized the subject from a previous theft, and it

On 2/20, officers responded to a theft near a local gas station on Farwell Dr. The subject grabbed some of the victim's money and fled on foot. The subject was located by a responding officer and positively identified by the victim. The subject, an adult out of Fremont, was arrested. #230220006

## **Robbery/Assault**

On 2/19, officers responded to a local retail store to a report of a subject assaulting a store employee. As officers arrived, the subject was being escorted back by the store's loss prevention for theft. The subject resisted and punched the employee. The subject, an adult out of Newark, was subsequently arrested. #230219017

## **Warrant Service/Possession of Burglary Tools**

On 2/19, a license plate reader alerted officers of a felony vehicle in the area of Stevenson Blvd and I-880. The vehicle was wanted for evading a neighboring agency. Officers located the vehicle at a gas station near Stevenson Blvd and Blacow Rd. Additional officers arrived in the area and conducted a vehicle stop. The subject was detained and found to have an active warrant for burglary out of a nearby City. A search also revealed burglary tools in the vehicle. The subject, an adult out of Union City, was arrested, and the vehicle was towed. #230219021
