Arson

Battery

On 2/23, officers responded to a fast-food restaurant in Centerville to the report of a subject exposing himself. Officers arrived and were unable to locate him. Approximately an hour later, another business in the area called to report the same subject acting aggressively and threatening staff and battering customers. Officers arrived and arrested the subject, whom the battered victim positively identified. #230223007

DUI

On 2/22, officers responded to a report of a suspected drunk driver traveling on Fremont Blvd. The caller reported seeing the vehicle drive on various sidewalks and over curbs. Officers located the vehicle and contacted the intoxicated driver. The driver, an adult out of Fremont, was arrested. #230222031

Shooting at Inhabited Dwelling

On 2/23, officers responded to a residence on Torrington Court regarding a possible targeted shooting into an occupied home. The reporting party advised that there were no injuries. Officers arrived and located casings on the street and sidewalk near the residence. Officers canvassed the scene and confirmed there were no injuries. Officers learned the shooting suspects(s) possibly targeted the occupants in a vehicle parked in the residence's driveway. This case remains under active investigation. #230223001

Tampering with Vehicle

On 2/21, officers responded to an apartment complex to a subject making entry into a vehicle and sleeping inside. Officers located the subject in the backseat, and the vehicle's rear window was shattered. Officers recovered a knife, metal rod, and pepper spray on the subject. The subject, an adult out of Fremont, was arrested. #230221008

Vandalism/Burglary Attempt

On 2/22, officers responded to an Irvington district shopping center to a security report of a subject trespassing in the area. Officers contacted the subject, who needed medical attention for cuts to his foot caused by shattered glass. Officers further investigated and found that a nearby business had broken glass to the entry door. Officers determined that the subject was responsible for the glass break. The subject, an adult out of Fremont, was medically cleared and arrested. #230222003

Miscellaneous Public Service

On 2/25, dispatch received multiple calls from the Niles District regarding hundreds of bicyclists blocking traffic and causing disturbances. The large group traveled from Hayward through Union City and settled near a business in Niles. A team of officers, including members of the UAV (drone), responded to gather information on the size and location of the crowd and attempted to disburse the crowd. Officers also contacted the business where the group gathered. After a short standoff, the mass of bicyclists rode away northbound on Niles into Union City. This incident remains under investigation. #230225017
