### Assault with a Deadly Weapon/Shots Fired

On 3/7, dispatch received reports of gunshots fired near Central Ave. Officers arrived on the scene and met with the initial reporting party. The reporting party described a group of local subjects who appeared intoxicated in a parking lot. An altercation ensued, and one subject pulled out a firearm while a second subject pulled out another firearm. The groups quickly retreated into their vehicles and fired shots into the air as they drove away. A canvass of nearby homes and vehicles noted no bullet strikes; however, officers located several casings of different calibers. This case remains under investigation. #230307033

## Attempted Carjacking

On 3/10, a victim was driving near Lake Arrowhead and Shaver Lake when three subjects surrounded the car, shattered the window, and attempted to pull the victim out of the vehicle. The victim was able to drive away and noticed the subjects continued to follow her through the Lake Arrowhead shopping center and onto the freeway. The victim lost sight of the suspects at Southbound 880. This case remains under investigation. #230310003

### Carjacking/Robbery

On 3/10, officers responded to a report of a carjacking and robbery at a gas station on Fremont Blvd. A victim was pumping gas when a subject approached him and hit him in the head with a metal object. The victim fell to the ground, and the subject stole the victim's belongings and took the victim's vehicle. This case remains under investigation. #230310002

### **Methamphetamine Sales**

On 3/13, officers observed a hand-to-hand drug transaction near Eugene St and Citrus Dr between a subject on a bicycle and two occupants in a vehicle. Officers stopped the vehicle and the bicycle. Both subjects were arrested, one adult out of Fremont and one adult out of Oakland. #230313002

### **Possession of a Loaded Firearm**

On 3/12, officers observed a suspicious vehicle with a false license plate near Fremont Blvd and Tamayo St. Officers conducted a traffic stop, searched the vehicle, and located a concealed firearm under the driver's seat. The driver, an adult out of Petaluma, was arrested. #230312002

### **Residential Burglary**

On 3/7, officers responded to a residential burglary on Crosspointe Cmn. The homeowner returned home from work to discover an opened back door. The victim learned that unknown subject(s) entered through the rear backyard and gained entry into the home by prying open a sliding glass window. The victim did not see anything moved, opened, or missing. #230307032

On 3/8, officers responded to an attempted residential burglary on Gramercy Ter. The reporting party indicated that an unknown subject opened their front door with a key. Officers located the subject nearby and determined that the subject had two active warrants for his arrest. The subject, an adult out of Fremont, was arrested. #230308007

### Robbery

On 3/12, officers responded to an armed robbery on Bonica Rose Ter. The victim arrived home and parked his vehicle. During this time, a vehicle stopped near the victim, and a subject exited the vehicle and demanded the victim's watch and jewelry. This case remains under investigation. #230312022

On 3/13, officers responded to a local retail store on Christy St to the report of a fight involving three subjects. The store's loss prevention team contacted the subject, and a fight ensued over the loss. The subject fled the scene before officers arrived. This case remains under investigation. #230313033

#### **Vehicle Recovery**

On 3/7, officers received an alert of a stolen vehicle traveling in the area of Fremont Bl and Enea Ct. Officers located the vehicle and conducted a traffic stop. The driver, an adult subject out of Fremont, was arrested. #230307020

On 3/12, officers received an alert of a stolen vehicle traveling on eastbound Mowry Ave from I-880. Officers located the stolen vehicle as it pulled into a parking lot and conducted a traffic stop. The driver, an adult subject out of San Jose, was arrested. #230312023
