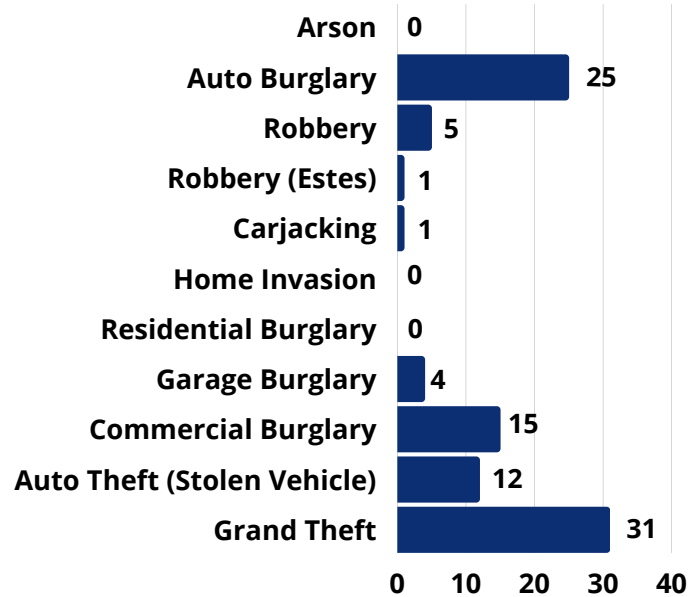




# Fremont Police Week In Review

## Assault and Robbery

On 3/22, officers responded to an assault and robbery at a business on Albrae St. The victim reported that a subject assaulted her, stole her phone, and fled on foot. The subject fled on foot while officers were en route. Officers located the subject nearby shortly after, and the witness and victim positively identified the subject. The subject, an adult out of Newark, was arrested. #230322018

## Commercial Burglary

On 3/25, officers responded to a commercial burglary at a church on Mowry Ave. A reporting party advised that they could hear banging noises in the rear area of the church and believed someone might be trying to break into the storage sheds. Officers arrived and located the subject attempting to hide behind an air conditioner unit. Further investigation found that the subject had also tried to break into other storage units on the property. The subject, an adult out of Fremont, was arrested. #230325003

## Mental Health Evaluation Hold

On 3/27, officers responded to a local motel on Fremont Blvd to a battery in progress. The reporting party (victim) advised that her adult son (subject) had battered her, and she could not leave the motel room. The subject was diagnosed with mental health conditions. Officers arrived and contacted the subject. The subject, an adult out of Fremont, was placed on a mental health evaluation hold. #230327003

## Robbery

On 3/22, officers responded to an attempted robbery on the 46000 block of Warm Springs Blvd. The victim parked her vehicle and saw a subject opening her front passenger door. The subject then attempted to snatch the victim's purse. During the struggle for the purse, the victim sustained minor scratches. The subject fled into a waiting vehicle with no loss. The subject's vehicle fled westbound towards I-680. This case remains under investigation. #230322029

## Robbery

On 3/25, officers responded to an armed robbery at a store at Fremont Hub. A lone subject armed with a handgun confronted an employee, took money from a register, and fled on foot. The employee was able to provide a description. This case remains under investigation. #230325029

## Grand Theft

On 3/22, Officers responded to a report of a gold-chain switch on the 200 block of Merrill Ave. The reporting party's mother met two subjects. The two subjects gave the victim gold bangles and placed a necklace on her. When the victim returned home, she noticed she had lost her original necklace and bangles. The subjects drove away in a white hatchback-type vehicle. This case remains under investigation. #230322035

## Possession of Drug Paraphernalia

On 3/24, officers conducted a pedestrian stop on a subject at a grocery store on Paseo Padre Pkwy. The Store security advised that the subject was actively panhandling. A search of his person revealed drug paraphernalia. The subject, an adult out of Fremont, was arrested. #230324020

## Stolen Vehicle Recovery

On 3/23, officers received an alert to a stolen vehicle near Osgood Rd and Auto Mall Pkwy. Officers located the vehicle in the parking lot of a retail store. Officers conducted a stop, and the driver, an adult subject out of San Jose, was arrested. #230323026

## Other Arrests:

On 3/24, officers conducted a follow-up investigation regarding a grand theft. Officers identified two subjects and learned they were staying at a local motel on Fremont Blvd. Officers observed the two subjects in a vehicle at the motel and conducted a traffic stop. Officers arrested the two subjects, one adult out of Alameda and one adult out of Fremont. #230319017
