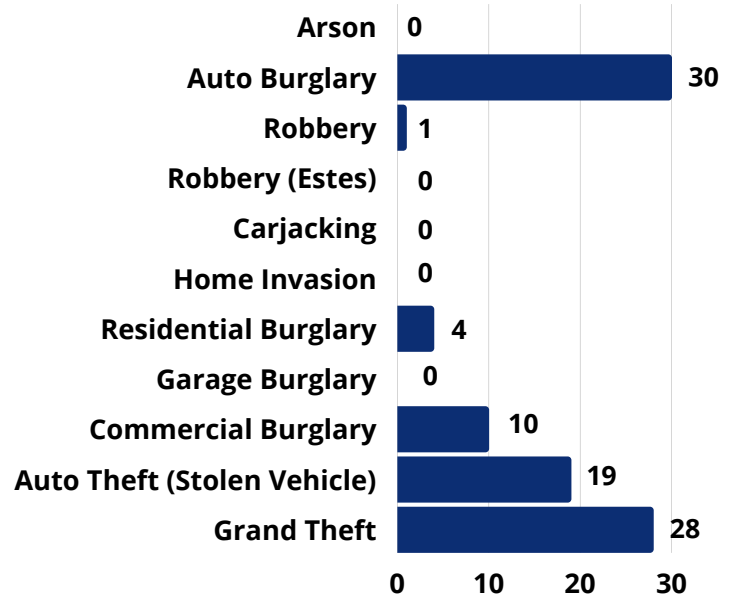




Fremont Police Week In Review

Assault with a Deadly Weapon

On 4/1, officers responded to a local hospital for an assault. A couple (victims) arrived for treatment at a local hospital emergency room. Upon their arrival, an unprovoked subject walked up behind them, grabbed a pole, and struck one of the victims in the back of the head, causing significant lacerations. After the assault, the subject sat down and waited for police arrival. The subject, an adult out of Fremont, was arrested. #230401022

On 4/2, officers responded to a domestic disturbance call on Winnipeg Gr. The female victim advised that her child's father (subject) threatened to harm her. The subject attempted to stab the victim with a screwdriver. Upon arrival, officers searched for the subject, who fled towards Auto Mall Pkwy. Additional units arrived and located the subject.

The subject, an adult out of Fremont, was arrested. #230402021

Mental Health Evaluation

On 3/30, dispatch received a call from a local manufacturing company reporting a possible active shooting. The caller reported hearing talks about a subject wanting to shoot people and saw someone with a firearm. Officers immediately responded to evaluate the situation and contacted their security and the original caller. Officers determined the caller to be heavily under the influence of a controlled substance. The reports of a shooting and firearm were unfounded. The caller, an adult out of Fremont, was arrested for being under the influence of drugs and placed on a mental health evaluation hold. #230330006

Residential Burglary

On 3/29, officers responded to an in-progress residential burglary at Lake Barlee Ln. The victim hid in their garage after hearing subjects smash a rear sliding glass door at the residence. As officers responded, they observed a vehicle driving away. Officers attempted to follow the vehicle, and it immediately fled. Several officers pursued the vehicle while others checked the victim's welfare and cleared the residence. The pursuit traveled northbound on I880 in heavy rain, and officers terminated the pursuit for public safety. The victim was unharmed, and the residence was clear. This case remains under investigation. #230329016

Residential Burglary

On 4/2, officers responded to an apartment complex on San Pedro Dr to the report of a possible attempted residential burglary. As officers arrived on the scene, they learned that four subjects ran southbound through the complex after they were interrupted by a homeowner. Officers reviewed surveillance cameras and obtained a description of all four subjects. Based on the footage, it appears that the subjects were kicking the doors of the apartment. Officers began searching the area and located two subjects, who were juveniles. Officers released the two juvenile subjects to their parents. This case remains under investigation. #230402019

Robbery

On 3/29, officers responded to a robbery on Galindo Dr. The victim had just returned home from a bank and parked her vehicle inside the garage. Upon exiting the vehicle, a subject stood near the victim and grabbed the victim's bag. The subject then fled in a nearby vehicle. This case remains under investigation. #230329012

Other Arrests

On 3/29, a community member called to report seeing a subject with a firearm and a bandana covering his face walking on Delaware Dr. Officers responded to the area, conducted a stop, and detained the subject. Officers did not locate a firearm on the subject or along his path; however, he possessed drug paraphernalia. The subject, an adult out of Fremont, was arrested. #230329011

On 4/2, officers responded to the intersection of Mission Bl and Niles Canyon Rd to the report of a subject armed with a rifle walking into the canyon. Officers arrived and located the subject, who did not have a firearm but had an outstanding felony warrant. The subject, an adult out of Fremont, was arrested. #230402018

On 4/3, officers responded to a report of a suspicious subject possibly sleeping in a vehicle. Officers contacted the subject, who has several probation dockets. Officers located vehicle keys, burglary tools, and methamphetamine inside the subject's vehicle. The subject, an adult out of Fremont, was arrested. #230403015
